

USAWP PNW&H Zone Regional Assignor Policy & Procedure

For use in Washington and Oregon only

Choosing a Regional Assignor:

- After an USAWP Event Host has been approved for a sanctioned USAWP Event in Oregon or Washington they will be contacted via email by the Zone Head Referee.
- The Zone Head Referee will provide the Event Host with the PNW&H Zone Regional Assignor Policy & Procedure document and ask which Assignor the host would like to use for their event.
- The host must choose a Board Approved Regional Assignor.
- Once an Assignor is chosen the Zone Head Referee will contact the Assignor and confirm that they are able to assign the event.
- If the Assignor declines the event the host will choose another Board Approved Regional Assignor.
- The Zone Head Referee must assist the chosen tournament Assignor as needed.
- The chosen Regional Assignor will send the Zone Head Referee an Arbiter spreadsheet with the assignments prior to the start of the Event.
- The Zone Head Referee will be responsible for inputting the tournament assignments into Arbiter and ensuring the referees are promptly paid.

Adding Regional Assignors:

- To be added to the Approved Regional Assignor list a candidate must be approved by a majority vote of the Zone Board.
- The current Zone Head Referee will be included on the Approved Regional Assignor list for their entire term, this will not require a vote of the Zone Board.

Removing Regional Assignors:

- Any Approved Assignor that formally requests to the Zone Board to be removed from the list will be removed without a vote of the Zone Board.
- Approved Assignors can be removed from the list by a majority vote of the Zone Board
- If an Approved Regional Assignor has not been chosen to assign a USAWP Event in two consecutive calendar years (Jan 1 – Dec 31st) they will be removed from the Approved Regional Assignors list.
